### **Position: Barista**

**Purpose:** The goal of the Center Barista is to bless the patrons utilizing the Center, building relationships where the love of Christ is shared. This will be done through excellent customer service in the preparation and serving of beverages as well as creating a welcoming and inviting environment for patrons to enjoy.

### **Duties:**

1. Attend appropriate initial training and required updates in order to prepare beverages with excellence.
2. Obtain food handling license.
3. Work assigned shift on agreed rotation. Find replacement when unable to fill scheduled shift and inform team leader of changed.
4. Be prepared to assist patrons with other services offered at the Center - information and required forms to rent space, information with current programs, etc.
5. Actively keep coffee bar area clean, stocked and organized.
6. Create an inviting and welcoming environment for patrons, seeking to build positive relationships.

**Time Commitment:** The team member will serve on an agreed rotation schedule for one year. The team member may also serve on occasional special events as their personal schedule permits.

**Training:** All team members are required to go through required training and obtain a food handling license. This will be provided by the Center at no cost to the team member,

**Benefits:** Team members will be a crucial part of building relationships with patrons of the Center, creating opportunities to share the love of Christ with the surrounding community.
